#### \*\*PRIEST'S CORNER\*\*

Dear Parishioners.

Christ is Risen! Truly, He is Risen! Recently I was having a tougher day than normal with many unexpected problems, request for meetings, delays, frustrations, and the like. Soon I found myself telling a staff member my tale of woe in all its intricate details when the person I was speaking to said, "Father, remember that Christ is risen!" to which I had already programmed myself to respond, "Truly, He is risen!" Very quickly I found my mind awakened to this life changing reality that was like the Sun (or the Son) breaking through the clouds of my negative emotions and once again reminding me that this one fact is larger, and greater, and more long lasting, than all that had led me to feel so overwhelmed and frustrated.

This reminded me that this is another good reason that the church celebrates Easter for such a long time. That we might not only take in the mystery and majesty of our Lord's resurrection but that we may be inundated with it! That we might overflow with it in thought, word, and deed. Then we can radiate with the same hope, the same joy as the first Christians on that Easter morning.

This reminder of the Lord's rising did not cancel the meetings or take away the problems I was having, but it did change the way I saw them. I had a hope that reminded me that these too would be for good one day and a trust in the presence of the Lord with me in that moment and every moment to come, that He would sustain me and even grow me in and through these things. Now every time I'm starting to feel overwhelmed, frustrated, or drained I remind myself out loud, "Christ is Risen!" And then I respond "Truly He is Risen" and so will I one day and all those I love who have died with this hope and faith. But also I will rise with and in the Lord now! And I will rejoice in the great things the Lord has for me now and has awaiting for me then! This is not just a thought but a Promise!

#### **Spring in the Desert**

Spring in the Desert is a ministry that accompanies those couples struggling with infertility by offering a place of respite and solidarity where they can know God's love for them and discover His unique call to fruitfulness.

Spring in the Desert is firmly rooted in the anthropology, ethics, and spirituality of the Catholic Church. As such, this ministry yields to the wisdom of the Church on all matters, most especially marriage, sexuality, the dignity of the human person, and her teachings on Artificial Reproductive Technologies. They affirm the goodness and witness of marriage, even when husband and wife experience seasons of infertility or loss. They uphold the giftedness of the child, who has the right to be conceived in the union of self-giving love of his/her mother and father. They reject any means of reproduction that diminishes the dignity of the marriage bond by introducing a third party into the act of conception. By keeping their focus on Christ, not on conception, the ministry gives witness to His divine love and mercy, and the goodness of His plan for our lives.

Spring in the Desert forms community with unique offerings for women, men and couples, meeting them wherever they are on the path of infertility. Through these encounters, space is made for a deeper renewal in relationships with oneself, a spouse, and God.

The ministry also raises awareness about the experience and unique grief of infertility to pastors, diocesan offices, and healthcare professionals, helping them to understand the needs of a couple struggling with infertility, and providing tools and resources to help them minister more effectively to hurting couples. Among pastoral ministers and healthcare professionals, Spring in the Desert is recognized as a trusted resource for couples experiencing infertility.
