# PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

## \*\*PRIEST'S CORNER\*\*

Friends,

A blessed Palm Sunday to you! And welcome to the holiest week of the Liturgical year! This is truly a privileged time and there are abundant graces available as we walk with Our Lord through his Passion, Death, and Resurrection.

Of course, as Catholics, there is no better way to do this than by attending the Sacred Triduum Liturgies: The Mass of the Lord's Supper, the Celebration of the Lord's Passion, and the Great Easter Vigil. The same way that Calvary is made truly present at every Mass, these events are made truly present in this week's celebrations.

However... for many families, getting to these liturgies simply isn't possible. For many others, the demands of work, school, or general business can make this feel like one more week among many. So, if you're looking for ways to celebrate Holy Week on your own and at home, here are a few suggestions.

### How to celebrate Holy Week if it's also a busy week:

**Decorate with Palms** – This one is a classic and you were probably planning to do it anyway. You can form the palms into a cross or place the full leaves behind a crucifix on any wall.

**Celebrate Spy Wednesday** – It's a tradition to fast and sacrifice on Wednesday of Holy Week as well as Good Friday to console and suffer with Our Lord in his betrayal by Judas. This is also an unofficial holiday for all Military/Intelligence/Law Enforcement veterans when we recall Christ's refusal to be deceived by his enemies. "And the Truth shall set you free." (Jn 8:32)

**Thursday family dinner** – If you can't attend the Mass of the Lord's Supper, at least have a meal together as a household to thank God for the gift of family.

**Come to the altar of repose** - Missed the Lord's Supper? Join him in the Garden! Even a brief visit to the altar of repose in the Friendship Room will be a beautiful opportunity for prayer.

**Stations of the Cross** – These will be offered publicly at 12 p.m. on Good Friday. But, if you're at work on Good Friday, you can always pray the Stations on your own, or as a family at home!

**Saturday morning Lauds** - The Liturgy of the Hours is always an excellent way to enter into prayer with and for the Church. You can pray Morning Prayer on your own or join others at 9 a.m. on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday at Sacred Heart.

**Read the Vigil Readings** – The "Mother of all Vigils" is not for the faint of heart. (But then again neither is any part of Christianity...) It contains 9 Scripture readings so we can watch the unfolding of God's miraculous work of Creation and Salvation. If you (or your little ones) don't have the endurance for the Vigil Mass, you can always read one or two (or 9) of those readings at home.

**40 Days For Life  
Healing after Abortion**

Today we close the 40 Days For Life Spring Campaign across our nation and around the world. There have been many occasions and stories about prayer saving the lives of our unborn children. However, not all the lives of the unborn have been saved.

For men and women who have experienced the trauma of abortion, sometimes the trauma takes decades to manifest. Other times, it's immediate. That was the case in Honolulu, where a couple leaving Planned Parenthood saw James' "Ask Me About Healing After Abortion" sign and took him up on the offer. James handed the man resources on post-abortion healing, while the woman slouched in the passenger seat, her eyes filled with tears. The man thanked James before driving off. "Keep praying for those who have had abortions to never do it again and to seek help," James said. "May Jesus touch their hearts and bring them closer to Him." Encounters like this encounter are painful.

In Overland Park, Kansas, a man who had never seen a 40 Days For Life vigil stopped to talk with prayer warriors. He shared that in 1968, when he was 18 years old, his girlfriend became pregnant. His girlfriend's mother flew her 17 year old daughter to New York City for an abortion that neither of them wanted. The couple later married and had children, but the man remained angry for years, until he became a Christian and found healing.

It's never too late to find the mercy and healing of Christ. In San Antonio, Texas, a woman saw an "Ask Me About Healing After Abortion" sign and stopped to confess that she still hurts after having an abortion 50 years ago. She studied biology in college, yet still believed the lie that the fetus was only a speck and not a baby. She wanted to avoid humiliation and instead gained a lifetime of regret. She was encouraged to pursue healing.

**Lord, You multiplied the meager offering of one boy to feed a hungry crowd. Please do the same with our humble prayers. Multiply the fruits of these 40 days. Grant us the humility to know our limitations, the wisdom to turn to You in moments of distress, and the grace to carry out Your will with trust and courage. Amen.**

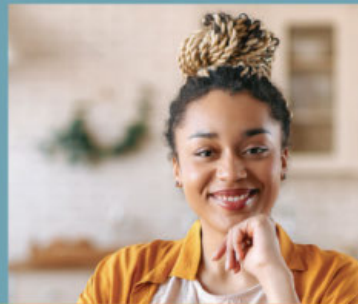
