# EASTER SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD

## \*\*PRIEST'S CORNER\*\*

Dear Parishioners,

Christ is risen, alleluia! Indeed He is risen, alleluia. Today is the greatest day of the year. It is the day when the Lord Jesus, on the third day after His passion, rose from the dead. He dies now no more, but ascended into heaven after forty days and now reigns there in glory forever. Through the ages of the Church He gathers the souls of His saints there with Him, until the last day when He will raise up even their bodies to share in His risen glory.

The glory of the resurrected life of the saints with Christ in heaven is the purpose of the work of our salvation: the Word became flesh, suffered, died, and rose from the dead, to bring human beings to heavenly glory. It's also the purpose of our whole Christian life. In fact, it's what the Holy Trinity had in mind when He created us in the beginning. We see here the goodness of God: He Himself is infinite and undiminished goodness; His purpose in His works is to share His goodness with His creatures, especially with human beings and the angels, by making them share in His own happiness. Suffering only enters the picture because of sin. Because of sin, humanity received the just punishment of suffering and death, even eternal death in hell. But how excellently God makes even the suffering of this life work for greater glory: the Word became man and performed the most heroic act of charity in dying for us. Now we too, who receive His grace, unite ourselves with His sacrifice by accepting suffering for love of God to satisfy for sins. By suffering, Christ and His saints gain an even more noble glory in heaven, the glory of a victory won.

And so we see how things stand: suffering is only the means; the goal is glory. All through the Easter season we raise our minds to our goal. We think of the risen Christ, the glory of His body, the happiness of His entire soul, now filled with the joy overflowing from His vision of the Divine Essence. We think of the forty days He spent with His disciples, an image of the happy fellowship the saints will enjoy with Him in heaven. We think of His Ascension, and of the happiness of the Saints who join Him there in undiminished, unending happiness. Finally, we think of the final resurrection, when the saints will shine with the glory of their own risen bodies. Thinking of such things is so important. First, it draws us to love God by telling us of the undiminished goodness of God who has prepared such things for us. Second, it teaches us to desire what He has prepared for us. We should desire Heaven. It will motivate us for the journey that leads there. May the Lord help us to rejoice today in His resurrected glory and in the hope of sharing in it ourselves.

**Christ Our Hope: In Every Season of Life**

From the time we are knit together in our mother's womb until we take our final breath, each moment of our life is a gift from God. While every season of life brings its own challenges and trials, each season also gives us new opportunities to grow in our relationship with God.

Today the gift is threatened in countless ways. Those who are most vulnerable, rather than receiving the protection they deserve, are all too often seen as a burden and as expendable. As new attacks on human life continue to emerge, we can be tempted to despair, but Christ instead offers us unfailing hope.

Hope is not false optimism or empty positivity. Christian hope is something much more profound and goes to the very depths of our identity as followers of Christ.

Like us, Christ entered the world through the womb of a woman. He willingly experienced the fullness of human suffering. He breathed His last on the cross at Calvary in order that He might save us. Therefore, "God is the foundation of hope: not any god, but a God who has a human face and who has loved us to the end" (Spe salvi 31).

Christians know "they have a future: it is not that they know the details of what awaits them, but they know in general terms that their life will not end in emptiness" (SS2). For this reason, a woman experiencing a difficult pregnancy, can find the strength to welcome her precious child into the world. A man facing a terminal diagnosis can see the end of his earthly life is only the beginning of eternal life with Christ.

The Church teaches us that "the one who has hope lives differently" (SS2). Christ's promise of salvation does not mean that we will be spared from suffering. Rather, the promise of salvation ensures that even in the darkest moments of our lives, we will be given the strength to persevere. By virtue of this Christian hope, we can face any challenge or trial. When the seas of life swell and we are battered by the waves, hope allows us to remain anchored in the heart of God. May we hold fast to Christ our hope, from the beginning of life to its very end.

Let us pray for all who work to build a culture of life: May the hope of the Resurrection renew and sustain them in their mission, let us pray to the Lord. Amen.

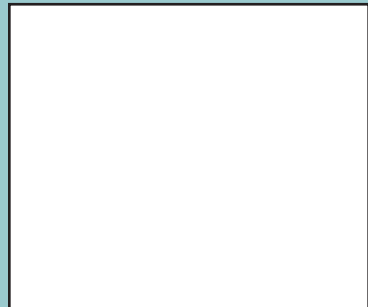
